## 1. Purpose

1.1 The academies within the Trust will follow the principles of the Trust uniform policy as laid out within this document. The Local Governing Body and/or the Principal as appropriate will define the detailed procedures for local implementation.

2.2 Charles Read academy will review this policy at least every year and assess its implementation and effectiveness. The policy will be promoted and implemented throughout the academy.

2.3 If your child does not attend in the correct uniform (including jewellery, make up and hair) you will be contacted by academy staff so the issue can be rectified. Until students are in the correct uniform Charles Read Academy reserves the right to place students in isolation, or send them home.
